## Documentary Evidence Requirement and Rehearsal Guidelines

### Documentary Evidence Required

At the meeting of the board on September 2, 2021, a motion was passed that requires all members of Saskatoon Concert Band Inc. to provide documentary evidence of being fully vaccinated for COVID-19, no later than Wednesday, September 22.

### Procedure

Bring your vaccination card or Saskatchewan eHealth COVID-19 vaccination record. A picture of either will also suffice. We will not be keeping any physical or electronic records. We will use a checklist.

### Guidelines for Rehearsals

- Self-monitoring
  - If you have signs or symptoms, stay home.
  - Let your conductor know.
- Masks must be worn
  - upon entry to the building.
  - if you are up and moving in the room.
  - at the end of rehearsal.
  - For those individuals who forget, masks will be available at the hall.
- Wash/sanitize hands on entry.
- All brass players must continue to use clean, individual spit rags, contained in a sealable plastic bag or sealable container.
- There will be a short (5 min.) rehearsal break, but no refreshments.
- Rehearsals will start at 7:30 p.m. and end no later than 9:15 p.m.
- Only personal water bottles are allowed.
- Music folders should still be taken home.
- The meeting room can be used for cases as it was before the pandemic.
- Coats – please use your chair. This may change when winter arrives.
- Chairs will be spaced as far apart as possible.
